The sound 'ouse' - as in the word 'house' The sound 'ere' - as in the word 'there'


Carefully Explain: The sound 'u' as in 'quiet'

I had a dream that Santa came to our house. He crept down the chimney, as quiet as a mouse.






He had a sack full of toys, just for us - there were lovely new dolls, cars, trucks and a shiny blue bus.
